**Pools open, city offices closed May 31 for Memorial Day holiday**

McKINNEY, Texas (May 26, 2010) – Memorial Day marks the first day of summer for most McKinney families. To coincide with the start of the summer, City of McKinney pools will be open. City offices and many city facilities also will be closed on Monday, May 31, in observance of the Memorial Day holiday.

The refuse and recycling collections will change for the holiday. There will be no pick-up on Monday, May 31. Pick-up will slide one day for the rest of the week. Monday’s pick up will be on Tuesday; Tuesday’s on Wednesday; Wednesday’s on Thursday; Thursday’s on Friday; and Friday’s on Saturday.
