Deadline extended to apply for open seats on McKinney Boards and Commissions

McKINNEY, TEXAS (July 6, 2010) – The deadline to apply for one of the open seats on city Boards and Commissions has been extended until Friday, July 9. Residents should apply to have the opportunity to get involved in helping to shape city policies for a variety of areas from libraries, historic preservation, economic development, to the arts.
