

## **Mayor Pro Tem Pete Huff**

Pete Huff grew up in north Dallas and graduated from North Dallas High School. He received Bachelor's degrees in Liberal Arts and Mechanical Engineering from Rice University in 1960. Huff was President of the student body and was awarded the outstanding student award. From 1960 to 1962, Huff studied at Harvard Business School and received a MBA degree.

Huff has served on the boards for the McKinney Chamber of Commerce, the Collin County Regional Airport, Transportation Board, the North Texas Municipal Waste Board and the Housing Finance Corporation. Huff was one of the founders of Volunteer McKinney and helped raise the initial funding of \$50,000. He was an integral part of Rebuilding Neighborhoods, an outgrowth of Project Reclaim.

Huff first became a candidate for McKinney City Council in May 2002. He has been elected three times and has served eight years. He is currently the Mayor Pro Tem and serves as the City Council Liaison for the McKinney Community Development Board, the Main Street Board and the County Commissioners.

Huff founded DYNAMCO in 1967 to design and manufacture high tech pneumatic valves. DYNAMCO moved from Dallas to McKinney In 1985 and grew to a multi-million dollar company that was sold in 2001. In 1990, Huff and a partner bought Wattmaster Controls based in Kansas City. He currently serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors.

Huff and his wife Nancy have two daughters. Dr. Carol Ann Huff is a doctor of Oncology and Laura Huff Wehrle is Director of Finance Workmen's Comp Division of Liberty Mutual.
