CONSTRUCTION INSPECTIONS
SAFETY PLANS

Safety Rules and Regulations are the Contractor's Obligation to be observed for Traffic and OSHA Requirements on all construction of this project. The Contractor shall be responsible to see that any and all provisions of the various regulations are met and compliance is obtained.

1. Traffic Control – When required by the Work, Contractor is responsible to submit a Traffic Control Plan (TCP) for approval. The Plan shall be compiled by someone with MUTCD qualifications; be specific to the project site; and shall comply with the MUTCD. The Contractor is responsible to monitor the plan as the Work progresses; ensure all work and workers are appropriately protected; and shall submit modifications for approval as needed. Contractor shall submit a copy of the proposed TCP with the qualifications certification in a timely fashion. A copy of the latest approved plan must be on site throughout construction.
 - Street Closures Required? Notify City Inspector 5 days prior to needing street closure. Traffic Control signs shall be placed and maintained during the life of the project as required. Traffic Control signs shall be removed or laid down when not in use. Contractor shall resolve any traffic control issues immediately upon the City's request.
2. Trench Safety - When required by the Work, the Contractor shall submit a trench safety plan for review. The plan shall include the recommended safety protection measures with the appropriate load requirements. The Contractor shall ensure that all protective measures located on site and all procedures on the project are in compliance with all aspects of the plan. The Contractor shall make daily inspections of the trench safety systems to ensure that the systems meet OSHA requirements. Daily inspection is to be made by a "competent person" provided by the Contractor. The Contractor shall provide copies of all related documentation to the Owner upon request.
3. Confined Space - When required by the Work, the Contractor shall submit a Confined Space Plan for review. The Contractor shall ensure that all procedures employed on the project are in compliance with all aspects of the Plan. The Contractor shall comply with all applicable rules and regulations. All related documentation will be made available to the Inspector on a daily basis. The Contractor shall provide copies of all related documentation to the Owner upon request.
4. Utility Locates – Call National 811 digging number 48 hours prior to construction.
 - Utility Verification - It is the Contractor's responsibility for verifying location and elevation of all existing utilities.

Utility Relocation - [Note if Utility Relocations are *scheduled, in-progress, or complete.*] Contractor shall notify the Construction Inspector and Project Manager IMMEDIATELY if franchise utilities are found to be in conflict with the proposed construction.
