REQUEST FOR DEFERRED DISPOSITION PROBATION (ONLINE)

To request Deferred Disposition without a court appearance, you must submit a copy of your valid driver's license or permit AND proof of valid auto liability insurance with your request.

PLEA

I, the Defendant in the above-identified case, do hereby enter my plea of NO CONTEST GUILTY to the above-offense and, by signing below, acknowledge that I waive the right to a jury trial and hearing by the Court, the right to review evidence, and the right to appeal in this case.

AGE AT THE TIME OF OFFENSE

At the time of the violation, I WAS NOT or WAS under the age of 25.

For moving traffic offenses only: If you were under the age of 25, State law requires that you complete a Driving Safety Course as a condition of your probation. Your Driving Safety Course Certificate must be completed and returned to the court by the end of your probationary term (within 90 days).

In addition, if you have a provisional Driver's License, State law requires that you complete a driving examination with the Texas Department of Public Safety and submit proof to the Court by the end of your probationary term.

- If the Court grants your request, you will be on probation for 90 days.
- You are providing full payment of the fine and court costs (total amount due online).
- You must not commit any other offenses, including traffic violations, during the term of your probation.
- **For Failure to Maintain Financial Responsibility offenses only: You must maintain auto liability insurance coverage continuously for the entire probationary term. This will be verified by the Court.**

If you successfully complete probation, the Court will dismiss the case at the end of the probationary period. If you violate any condition of your probation, you will be scheduled to appear in Court for a Show Cause Hearing; at the hearing, the Court may decide to enter a final judgment and a conviction may be reported to the Texas Department of Public Safety or as otherwise required by law.

By signing below, I do solemnly swear or affirm that the following statements are true and correct:

- I am the person named in the above-referenced citation;
- At the time of the offense, I was 17 years old or older;
- I am not currently on Deferred Disposition, nor have I completed Deferred Disposition within the 12 months before the date of this citation;
- I possess a valid driver's license or permit;
- I have current, valid automobile liability insurance coverage;
- I did not hold a Commercial Driver's License (CDL) on the offense date and do not currently hold a CDL;
- I am not charged with driving 25 mph or more over the posted speed limit, passing a school bus or failing to obey a school crossing guard;
- This offense did not involve an accident resulting in property damage or personal injury;
- The offense did not occur in a construction zone with workers present.

I hereby enter my plea and request for deferred disposition probation in this matter.
