

McKinney Public Library Unattended Child Policy

- Children of all ages are welcome to use the Library. Staff members are available to help children use Library materials or services. The Library, however, is not able to provide childcare services.
- Responsibility for the welfare and the behavior of children using the Library rests with the parent, guardian, or a caregiver. Though the staff will respond with care and concern, they cannot assume responsibility for children's safety and comfort when they are unattended.
- Young children should be attended and adequately supervised by a parent, guardian, or caregiver who is a responsible person of at least 12 years of age. Children who are 12 and older may use the library unsupervised provided that they are able to behave appropriately.
