

TexShare Card

Information for MPLS patrons

The TexShare Card allows you to have direct access to books and other library materials that are not available at this library. The TexShare card is a privilege for those who have demonstrated a pattern of responsible library usage.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the TexShare Card Program, you must:

1. Be a McKinney Public Library System card-holder in good standing for at least six months. Good standing means that any fees incurred have been paid.
2. Patron must be 18 years of age.
3. Agree to present valid photo identification along with the TexShare Card in order to borrow materials from participating TexShare libraries.
4. Agree to return materials to the library from which they were borrowed, not to your home library, as outlined in the lending library's TexShare Card policy.
5. Be responsible for any charges for late, damaged, or lost materials. Unpaid fees or items not returned will result in the termination of your TexShare borrowing privileges.

Lending policies are made by the individual libraries that participate in the TexShare Card program and will vary from library to library. Be sure to check the lending policies for the library you wish to use.

How you can participate:

1. Register for and receive a TexShare card from the McKinney Public Library System.
2. Consult the <https://www.tsl.texas.gov/texshare/card> website to see the list of libraries which participate and the specific lending policies of the library you wish to visit.
3. Present your TexShare card at the reciprocating library's circulation desk to activate your checkout privileges. You will be required to show a photo ID.
4. Check out the books or other material at the circulation desk. It is your responsibility to take care of your borrowed materials and to return them on time.
